Discover the natural beauty and unique biodiversity of this region as you explore the jungle, see animals in their natural habitat, interact with local communities and immerse your senses in the wonder of the Amazon.

TROPICAL ADVENTURE 5 DAYS / 4 NIGHTS

ITINERARY SUMMARY

Day 1.- Visit Organic Agroforestry Farm. Day 2.- Excursion to Sandoval Lake in the Tambopata National Reserve. Return to the hotel. Rest, in the evening: Jungle by night. Day 3.- Excursion to La Cachuela Parrot Clay Lick, Visit to Inkaterra Canopy, in the afternoon: piranha fishing in Yacumama Lake. Day 4.- Morning: Canopy Tree Climbing, rest, Kayak in the Madre de Dios River. Day 5.- Check out and return to the city.

DAY 1

PUERTO MALDONADO/ HACIENDA HERRERA



ARRIVAL

You will be met at the airport or bus station and we will embark to Hacienda Herrera, traveling about 20 minutes by boat on the Madre de Dios River. After arrival we will give you all the information about your stay and you can rest a bit before your first discovery activity!

VISIT OUR ORGANIC AMAZON FARM

During the visit to our farm you will learn about organic Amazonian agroforestry and appreciate different plantations of tropical crops, such as bananas, papaya, guava, cacao, carambola, mango, acerola, pineapple, sugar cane, oranges, tangerines, lemons, avocado, caimito, cocona, Amazonian chili and yucca. Depending on seasonal availability, you can also taste them!

DAY 2

HACIENDA HERRERA- LAGO SANDOVAL



TAMBOPATA NATIONAL RESERVE - SANDOVAL LAKE

One of the most beautiful lakes in the Peruvian Amazon and the Tambopata National Reserve, Lake Sandoval is home to giant river otters, caimans, different species of monkeys, turtles, a variety of bird species and butterflies. Our excursion will start very early in the morning, leaving from the lodge by boat and then with a 3 km hike in the middle of the reserve to reach the lake. Afterwards we will slowly navigate by paddle boat close to the vegetation of the lake trying to spot as many animals as we can surrounded by a wonderful landscape.

Duration: half day.

Breakfast during the excursion. We will return to the lodge for lunch, then we will have time to rest and relax until the start of our next experience...

TAMBOPATA SUNSET

We will venture down the Tambopata River until we reach the best view of the sunset. We will wait together for the arrival of the night. Afterwards, we will return to search for nocturnal wildlife along the river banks. Hopefully we will spot many caimans, capybaras and nocturnal birds!



DAY 3

HACIENDA HERRERA- COLPAA CACHUELA- INKATERRA CANOPY WALK WAY



CACHUELA PARROT CLAY LICK

We will leave Hacienda Herrera at 5:00 a.m. for a 45-minute boat ride upriver to reach the Cachuela clay lick when the parrots are most active. The Cachuela clay lick is the perfect place for bird lovers to see parrots and parrots, such as the yellow-fronted parakeet, the mealy parrot and occasionally the blue-headed macaw and other small macaws. We will continue watching the activity of the clay lick as we enjoy the sunrise on the boat!

INKATERRA CANOPY WALK WAY

We will visit a 40 m. tower linked to a complex system of suspension bridges in the tree canopy. In this experience you will enjoy a breathtaking view that will show you the life of the jungle from above. A sense of connection between this network of towers, bridges and platforms will be revealed. If you are attentive, you will be able to witness different jungle birds, such as woodpeckers, trogons and toucans, among others!

Duration: 2 hours



We will return to the lodge for lunch and rest for our next experience.





PIRANHA FISHING

The Yacumama Lagoon is one of the most important wetlands in the region. It is currently part of a conservation project, and is home to thousands of parrots and macaws that roost in the area. This natural area is managed by people from the community of Santa Teresa, and they promote ecotourism to self-finance their project and invite us to be part of their initiative. Enjoy an afternoon of piranha fishing and help conserve this natural paradise.

Duration: 3 hours

DAY 4

HACIENDA HERRERA/ RIO MADRE DE DIOS



TREE CLIMBING

Climbing an Amazon Mother Tree is a very profound experience that will make you feel truly part of the jungle that surrounds you. From our 25-meter Lupuna platform you will enjoy a unique experience and the wonderful view of the jungle from above. Once at the top, you will be able to take pictures and, if we are lucky, appreciate the birds and wildlife that live in the forest canopy.

KAYAK EN EL RÍO MADRE DE DIOS

Kayaking on an Amazon river is an activity that will deeply nurture your connection with the rainforest. Just paddle down the Madre de Dios River and enjoy the awesome feeling of paddling in the Amazon basin.

While paddling downstream, you may also see wild animals among the riparian vegetation and amidst a breathtaking sunset. After a couple of hours of fun paddling on the river, we will return upstream by boat to Hacienda Herrera.

Duration of tour: 2 hours

We will return to the lodge to rest for our next experience....



NIGHT WALK

After sunset, we will head out for an exciting night walk through the jungle on a trail that starts near the lodge; if you are lucky, you will encounter poison dart frogs, praying mantises, giant spiders and other animals with incredible and bizarre adaptations to life in the dark.

Duration of tour: 1 hour

DAY 5

Breakfast at the Lodge, RETURN TO THE CITY

We will return to the city by boat at the end of your last excursion, usually in the late morning.

Note: Check-out is at 10:00 am. You can relax in the lodge's restaurant lounge until your transfer to Puerto Maldonado. Lunch is not included on your departure day but can be arranged with advanced notice (additional cost applies).
